Music and Movements

- Action song – Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes (recognizes body parts, improves coordination)
- Clapping (slow and fast) (develops sense of rhythm and listening skills)
- Free dance with music (builds confidence and self-expression)
- Identify sounds (clap, bell, drum) (enhances auditory discrimination)
- Follow simple teacher actions (improves attention and instruction-following)
